Conference Venue Ramada Plaza Hotel Jeju

The RE'19 conference will be held in Ramada Plaza Jeju Ocean Front. The Ramada Plaza Jeju Hotel modeled after the Hohwa Cruise Ship, floats on the waterfront of Jeju-do Island.
